

NEW INFORMATION REGARDING PET PRODUCT RECALLS

Markham, Ontario, May 4, 2007. In a press release dated April 30, 2007 disclosing first quarter financial results, Pet Valu, Inc. ("Pet Valu") stated, under the heading "Vendor Product Recalls", that " ... the number of (recalled) products carried by the Company is limited and none of the Company's private label products were among the products recalled".

On May 2, 2007, Menu Foods Income Trust issued a news release announcing a further recall of products which, while not directly containing identified contaminated ingredients, could have been cross-contaminated in the production of products for other customers. This latest recall involves production runs of four Pet Valu private label brands of canned pet food consisting of twelve flavours in Canada and six flavours in the U.S. that were manufactured between December 6, 2006 and March 7, 2007.

Pet Valu has removed all such recalled products from its store shelves for replacement with product that is not susceptible to cross-contamination. Pet Valu does not anticipate any material effect from this recall and replacement of these products. Also, Pet Valu has initiated independent testing of production runs affected by this recall, so as to address customers' concerns in relation to any potential exposure.

Pet Valu dry private label products have been made in plants that have not used any of the tainted ingredients from China, or that have been inspected by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration.

Pet Valu is a specialty retailer of pet food and pet-related supplies operating company-owned and franchised locations in Canada and the U.S. The TSX stock symbol for Pet Valu Canada Inc., the Pet Valu group's TSX-listed company, is PVC.
